*Dear Judge Webre*

My attention has been drawn by the Registrar of the recent email you had sent on 2 November 2013 to members of the Tribunal as well as to several others.

After careful thought and deep reflection, as President of the Tribunal, it is with profound regret to note that you had openly taken the position of being an "Applicant/Complainant" before the Tribunal for a restraining order against certain named respondents. By virtue thereof, as you are one of the Judges sitting at the Hearing it has now become highly improper for you to be part of the panel of judges at the Hearing.

In the circumstances, to ensure that all the panel judges are free from any apparent and oblique future complaints and criticisms, I have no alternative but to advise you not to sit in this particular Hearing. I would have to nominate another Judge in your place for this Hearing.

In meanwhile, the Sec-Gen informs me that the airline ticket already furnished to you may be used for later purposes.
